

Pool Usage Guidelines

Thank you for cooperation. To ensure a safe and comfortable experience for all guests, please review the following guidelines and terms of use.

1. Eligibility & Procedures

- **Eligible Guests:** Available for both staying guests and day-trip guests.
- **Usage Before Check-In / After Check-Out: ***
 - You may use the pool before checking in, provided you complete the necessary procedures at the front desk first.
 - The pool is also available after check-out. However, please note that an additional fee will be charged if you wish to use the communal bath (Daiyujjo) after checking out.

2. For Guests with Children

- **Parental/Guardian Supervision:** Children of elementary school age and younger must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Please keep a close eye on your children while they are swimming (including when using swim rings).
- **Children in Diapers:**
 - Children who are not yet potty-trained must wear swim diapers (waterplay pants) underneath their swimsuits and use the "Toddler Pool" only.
 - Swim diapers are available for purchase at the 1st-floor front desk.
- **Spectators in the Pool Area:** Poolside viewing is strictly limited to parents/guardians of participating children or companions of pool users.

3. Attire & Prohibited Items

- **Attire & Footwear:**
 - Please wear footwear, such as beach sandals, when entering the poolside area.
 - Please do not enter the water in clothing other than swimsuits, or while wearing footwear (including outdoor shoes).
 - Please remove all hairpins, jewelry, and accessories before entering the water. Additionally, appropriate attire must be worn (swimming completely naked is prohibited).
- **Prohibited Items:**
 - **All food and beverages** (including chewing gum, tablets, candies, etc., while swimming).
 - **Large pool toys/floats** (swim rings 120cm or larger, rubber boats, tents, parasols, etc.).
 - **Hazardous items & others** (glassware, metal objects, knives/blades, explosives, snorkels, fins).
- **Notes:**
 - *Please do not enter the water holding towels, hand towels, or cloths.*
 - *Please take all your trash home with you.*

4. Hygiene & Health Management

- **Showering Before Entering:** To maintain water quality, please wash off all makeup, suntan oil, etc., before entering. Always rinse off in the shower when entering/exiting the pool and before/after using the restroom.
- **Restricted Guests:** Admission is strictly prohibited for anyone forbidden from swimming by a doctor, individuals suspected of having infectious diseases, or those under the influence of alcohol (intoxicated).
- **Illness & Injuries:** First aid is available. Please notify a staff member immediately if you feel unwell or get injured. (Please note there is no doctor on-site. In an emergency, an ambulance will be called).
- **Upon Leaving:** Please rinse your eyes and gargle when leaving the pool.

5. Safety Prohibitions (Rules)

The poolside is very slippery. Please refrain from the following dangerous activities:

- **Dangerous Activities on the Poolside:** Running, wrestling, carrying someone on your shoulders, throwing people, or throwing objects.
- **Dangerous Activities in the Water:** Diving, prolonged underwater swimming (submersion).
- **Photography/Filming:** Photography and video recording using cameras, mobile phones, or other devices while in the water is prohibited.
- **Others:** Reserving space near aisles, entrances, or doorways; smoking (the pool area is strictly non-smoking; please use the designated smoking areas inside the hotel); entering staff-only areas.

6. Important Notes (Disclaimer)

- **Luggage & Valuables:** Please use the lockers and manage your belongings at your own risk. Valuables, such as wallets, can be held at the front desk.
- **Damage & Compensation:** Items in the pool area are constantly at risk of getting wet. Please be careful with mobile phones and other precision electronics. The hotel cannot guarantee or compensate for any damage, tearing, or discoloration of swimsuits or personal belongings.
- **Suspension of Operations:** Swimming may be suspended or pool operations cancelled without prior notice due to weather, fire, accidents, or other unforeseen troubles. In the event of an emergency, please follow the staff's instructions and evacuate promptly.
- **Staff Instructions:** If staff members determine an action to be dangerous or a nuisance to other guests, you must stop immediately upon their instruction. Failure to comply may result in being asked to leave the premises.
- **Liability:** The hotel takes absolutely no responsibility for any trouble, accidents, or injuries caused by guest carelessness or violation of these regulations.
